From the south

- Take Interstate (I)75 north to exit 59 (Benchwood/Wyse Road).
- At the end of the exit, turn right onto Benchwood/Wyse Road.
- Turn left onto Webster Street.
- Turn left onto Park Center Drive.
- The Dayton Customer Service Office is the first building on the right.

From the north

- Take I-75 south to exit 59 (Benchwood/Wyse Road). Stay in the middle lane.
- Turn left onto Benchwood/Wyse Road.
- Turn left onto Webster Street.
- Turn left onto Park Center Drive.
- The Dayton Customer Service Office is the first building on the right.

From the east or west (Please be aware of the construction zone and drive safely.)

- Take I-70 to I-75 south to Dayton (exit 33A). Remain in the right lane.
- Take I-75 south to exit 59 (Benchwood/Wyse Road). Stay in the middle lane.
- At the end of the exit, turn left onto Benchwood/Wyse Road.
- Turn left onto Webster Street.
- Turn left onto Park Center Drive.
- The Dayton Customer Service Office is the first building on the right.

Description: The Dayton BWC Service Office is located at 3401 Park Center Drive, Suite 100, in Dayton, Ohio. From the south, take I-75 N to Exit 59 (Benchwood/Wyse Rd). At the end of the exit, turn right onto Benchwood/Wyse Road. At the second light, take a left onto Webster Street. Take the first left onto Park Center Drive. The service office is the first building on the right. From the north, take I-75 S to Exit 59 (Benchwood/Wyse Rd). Stay in the middle lane. At the end of the exit, turn left onto Benchwood/ Wyse Road. At the third light, turn left onto Webster Street. Take the first left onto Park Center Drive. The service office is the first building on the right. From I-70 (east or west), Exit at 33A (I-75 S to Dayton), staying to the right. Take Exit 59 and follow the directions above in "From the north." Please be aware of the Construction Zone and drive safely.
